NSPC Brain & Spine Surgery Launches Trigeminal Neuralgia Institute of New York (TNINY), A Specialized Center of Care for Facial Pain Patients

(February 28, 2026 – Rockville Centre, NY) NSPC Brain & Spine Surgery (NSPC) of Rockville Centre, NY, has launched a specialized “care center” to better serve patients with trigeminal neuralgia (TN), a chronic, hard-to-diagnose facial pain condition affecting the trigeminal nerve. Called the Trigeminal Neuralgia Institute of New York (TNINY), the new department will be overseen by NSPC neurosurgeon Michael H. Brisman M.D., F.A.C.S., a board-certified expert in the diagnosis and treatment of TN and other facial pain conditions.

“So many of the patients I see,” notes Dr. Brisman, “tell me that they suffered unnecessarily because they couldn’t find a physician who was familiar with TN. Since I’m one of the few neurosurgeons practicing in the New York metropolitan area with a special interest in TN, our new center will address this challenge and raise awareness about the advanced, individualized care available at NSPC.”

Dr. Brisman has successfully treated thousands of patients with TN during the nearly 30 years he’s been in practice on Long Island. In addition to medical management, he often uses such minimally invasive procedures as stereotactic radiosurgery (SRS) and percutaneous trigeminal rhizotomy to address TN, as well as the standard microvascular decompression (MVD).

“I have a passion for helping people find innovative solutions for their facial pain,” asserts Dr. Brisman. “It’s a clinical interest that I shared with my late father, Ronald Brisman, who was also a neurosurgeon with an expertise at treating TN. I believe he would approve of TNINY because of the life-changing relief that the right care can bring to patients.”
